## TEAS Testing Preparation Schedule

### Introduction:

Welcome to your TEAS testing preparation schedule! It is designed to help you excel in the TEAS exam. It is only a suggestion that you may follow should you wish

### **Week 1: Familiarization and Assessment**

1. Select a TEAS testing date and register
2. Create an account with ATI
3. Research the TEAS exam format and context
4. Take the TEAS practice test to identify your strengths and weaknesses. Free practice test is available at the NNMC Ben Lujan Library
5. Based on practice, test results gather study materials and resources to help strengthen your weakness.

### **Week 2: Content Review**

1. Dedicate specific days to review each test subject: Reading, Math, Science and English
2. Use TEAS study guide and textbooks to reinforce concepts
3. Take practice quizzes for each subject to gauge your understanding

### **Week 3: Final Review and Strategy**

1. Review high-priority topics and challenging questions
2. Develop test-taking strategies for time management
3. Take a full-length practice test to simulate the actual exam

### **Exam Day:**

1. Ensure you have all required materials (ID, Admission ticket, etc.)

2. Get a good night's sleep before exam
3. Stay calm, focused and confident during the test
4. Read carefully all questions
